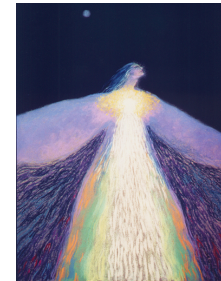


# Boulevard United Methodist Church on Broad

1. **It's an area.** Our congregation is a part of the Virginia Conference.

Cambodia	\$40,000	Community health & agricultural development
Brazil	\$20,000	Ministry with children; shade & fresh water
Mozambique	\$20,000	Lay leadership development
Virginia	\$30,000	Just Neighbors immigrant legal counsel
